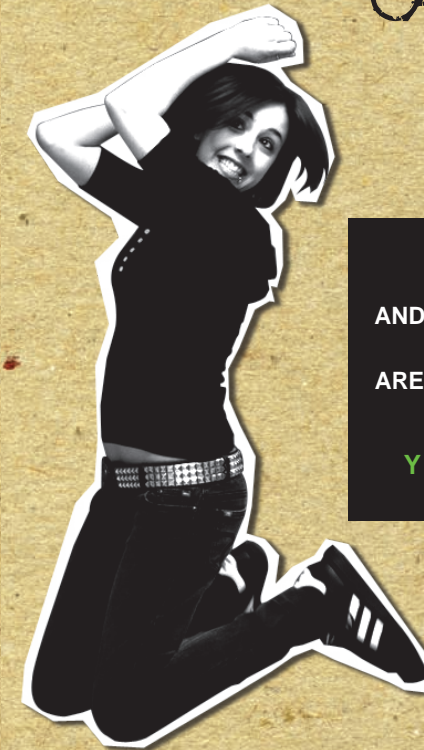

WHAT IS YGREEN?

The Y Green project is a residential sustainability project where local young people are trained and then employed to conduct home sustainability consultations in their community.

The consultations involve providing advice and information on household energy efficiency and the products that are available to reduce energy usage.

TRAINING

You'll be trained as a Home Sustainability Adviser through a FREE nationally recognised short course.

You'll complete the Course in Home Sustainability Assessment (21854VIC) which includes the technical information needed to complete a residential sustainability consultation, as well as customer service skills, first aid, and occupational health and safety. The course covers the four main aspects of residential sustainability:

- Energy
- Water
- Waste and Recycling
- Garden and Environs

EMPLOYMENT

After you've completed the training, you'll get paid to provide Home Sustainability Assessments to local households and provide advice to residents about what they can do to make their homes greener and more sustainable. And you'll receive all the tools and training you need to do it.

All Home Sustainability Advisers in the Y Green program work in pairs and the consultation, focused on ENERGY and WATER, takes approximately 45 minutes.

Most of the work is in the afternoons/evenings and weekends – when most householders are at home.

Once you've completed the Y Green program there are plenty of employment opportunities.....utility companies, local government, real estate, and construction industries would all be interested in employing young people with these green skills.
